

Foam Mooring Buoy

For mooring buoy applications, the self-fendering properties of these foam buoys make them far preferable to steel buoys which inevitably damage vessels. And, unlike other hard-shell or composite buoys made of polyethylene and/or polyurethane, foam buoys do not fade or yellow, and will not take on water if struck and punctured.

These mooring buoys are made of a extremely durable closed cell foam and have been known to last upwards of 10 years (pictured here with pick up buoy and pendant attached)
